

Softball Team Registration Process - 2020

1. Every team must fill out the new roster forms dated 2020. 1) forms must be completely filled out, legibly and submitted with a copy of a photo I.D. for every player 2) must submit 1 additional form of ID for each player listed on the roster 3) submit a check for the league entrance fee made out to Greenburgh Parks & Recreation. *These three steps must be completed before any team will be admitted to the League!*
2. Teams entering as **Resident Teams MUST** submit a copy of a drivers license or valid current Unicard for the 10 **Unincorporated** Greenburgh Residents on their rosters before applications are considered.
3. Any requests for any schedule conflicts MUST be made in writing before April 1, 2020. We will make every effort to accommodate your requests. *Once the schedules is made up there will be no changes made under any circumstances.*
4. We will make every attempt to have teams play an even number of early evening, mid-evening games, and late evening games.
5. League standings will be updated bi-weekly and posted on Fridays at the Rumbrook Park Office. Standings will also be posted weekly on the town's Web Page (www.greenburghny.com)
6. The use of alcohol on park property will not be tolerated. Anyone who is found using alcohol on park grounds will be automatically suspended for their next 3 games. A second offense will result in expulsion from the league.
7. **The season is anticipated to start the week of April 20, 2020 – field conditions permitting.**
8. No games will be played on May 25, 2020 (Memorial Day).
9. March 23, 2020 is the deadline for returning 2019 teams to hand in League Fees and rosters and ID photos to guarantee their spot in the league.
10. The deadline for new teams / League fees, Photo I.D.'s and completed roster form submission is March 31, 2020. **No teams will be permitted to register after March 31, 2020**
11. Roster changes may be made until May 22nd 2020. After May 22nd 2020, **only** players who live in the Unincorporated Town of Greenburgh, who have a valid current Unicard and who have not played during the season may be added to the roster. A copy of photo I.D. must accompany any additions to the roster.
