Dear Unicard Holders,

While the Town of Greenburgh is pleased to have been able to open up the Anthony F. Veteran Park pools during this pandemic, I would like to emphasize to all of you the importance of wearing a cloth face covering (mask).

We really want you to enjoy the park, and the mask requirement is for your own safety as well as the safety of others. If compliance is not followed, patrons will be asked to leave the facility.

Summary of Mask Requirements

- Everyone age 2 years and older must wear a mask when arriving and leaving the facility.
- All must wear a mask when walking to their seating area, restrooms, along the walkways, pool office, and snack bar area.
- Masks should not be worn when walking up to and from the pool to swim or when seated in your own area, 6 feet or farther away from non-household members.
- Masks cannot be worn when in the water.
- Masks are required when adults are in the interactive (children's water play area) pool, whether they are sitting on the edge of the pool or standing with no intention of getting their face wet. However, if adults are playing in the water with their children where they can get their mask wet, they should not wear a mask.
- Masks are required when using the restroom facilities or concession area.

Greenburgh Parks & Recreation is happy to announce that A.F. Veteran Park pool will open for the season on Monday, July 6. Please note the below rules, guidelines and information points.

- A reservation online or by phone must be made in order to enter the pool (300 max per session). There will be two sessions per day: 9am to 1pm, and 2pm to 6pm.
- Only verified residents of the unincorporated area of Greenburgh are eligible (no guests).
- You must have a resident account to make a reservation.
- You will be allowed to register for only one session per day.
- You must have a valid current unicard or a season pass.
- Reservations can be made from 12 noon the day before you plan to swim.
- A parent/legal guardian must accompany all children 15 years of age or younger.
- Patrons will pay daily rates to enter the pool (\$8 adult, \$6 senior/youth).
- A mask/face covering will be required to enter the facility.
- Food concessions will be open under New York State social-distancing protocols.
- Bathrooms will be open.
- Showers will be closed.
- Social distancing: Visitors must wear a mask if they cannot maintain 6-foot distance. Masks cannot be worn in the water.
