## 2020 FALL SOCCER REGISTRATION

The Town of Greenburgh Department of Parks and Recreation has partnered with *DiBernardo Soccer School* to offer a fall recreational youth soccer program where players will be coached in weekly trainings and small sided games by *3x - D1 "Coach of the Year"* and *2019 D1 National Champion Coach Marcus DiBernardo* and members of his college coaching staff!



- ⚽ All players will *learn from and play for college coaches* during each session!
- ⚽ Program is *open to boys and girls ages 6-17 years old.*
- ⚽ All skills trainings and games will be under the watchful eye of Coach DiBernardo and his staff.
- ⚽ Your chance to play *Friday nights under the lights!*

**PROGRAM:** All players will learn from and play for college coaches during each session. Each week players will participate in small group skills training sessions followed by small sided games under the watchful eye of Coach DiBernardo and his staff. Training/games will be played on Friday (10+ yr olds - evenings) and Saturdays (6-9 yrs olds - mornings/afternoons) beginning *Friday September 25<sup>th</sup>* and ending in (early/mid) November weather pending. All players will be placed in pods of 8 which will practice/play together as a team throughout the 7 week program. Boys and girls ages 6 & 7 years old will play in coed pods/teams while all 8 - 17 year olds will play in separate pods/teams. **THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT CHILDREN FROM THE SAME CLASS/SCHOOL WILL BE ON THE SAME POD/TEAM.**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Participation in the *DiBernardo Soccer School* is open to all residents of unincorporated Greenburgh as well as all non-residents interested in playing!
